All payments of child support should be made to the Department of Justice, Child Support Accounting Unit, P.O. Box 14506, Salem, Oregon, 97309 **by electronic payment withdrawal (EPW) or electronic funds transfer (EFT).** Petitioner requests that collection, accounting, disbursement, and enforcement services be provided by the Department of Justice. In addition, support for a child attending school (between the ages of 18 and 21) as defined by Oregon law shall be distributed by the Department of Justice directly to the child subject to ORS 107.108.
